Residence Halls & Refectory

The advantage of the CZU dormitories is their location on the university campus. Prices range from roughly 160 EUR to 280 EUR for one month of standard accommodation, and from 420 EUR to 600 EUR for premium accommodation. CZU also offers housing in off-campus external residence halls.

Our university refectory (Menza) offers lunch and dinner. You can choose from sweet or savoury, meat or vegetarian dishes, salads, and deserts. Each student can use the subsidy programme and get a meal for a very affordable price.
